Board Ethics Statement

- To ensure that the Emergency Nurses Association governing body makes a genuine

commitment to its ethics initiative for the overall good of this association.

- To reduce the threat of misconduct, fraud, scandal, corruption, and litigation.

- To encourage ethical decisions and responsible behavior.

Policy

The ENA Board of Directors will adopt and abide by a stated Code of Board Member Ethics.

Standards/Criteria

In addition to the ENA Bylaws, the ENA Code of Ethics, the Confidentiality Policy and the Conflict of Interest Policy, the NM ENA Board of Directors will be accountable to itself for its conduct and will abide by the Board Member Code of Ethics. This statement promotes the highest standards of association service and personal conduct.

Adherence to these standards is expected from the Board Members and serves to ensure confidence in the integrity and service of NM ENA's leaders.

ENA Board Member Code of Ethics

An NM ENA Member of the Board of Directors agrees to:

- Represent the interests of all people served by this association

- Agrees to abide by the ENA Conflict of Interest Policy
- Keep confidential information confidential
- Approach all Board issues with an open mind, prepared to make the best decision for the Emergency Nurses Association
- Do nothing to violate the trust of those who elected the Board to serve
 - Focus efforts on the mission, vision and purpose of the ENA and not on personal goals
 - Exercise authority as a Board member only when acting in a meeting with the full Board or as delegated by the Board

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
